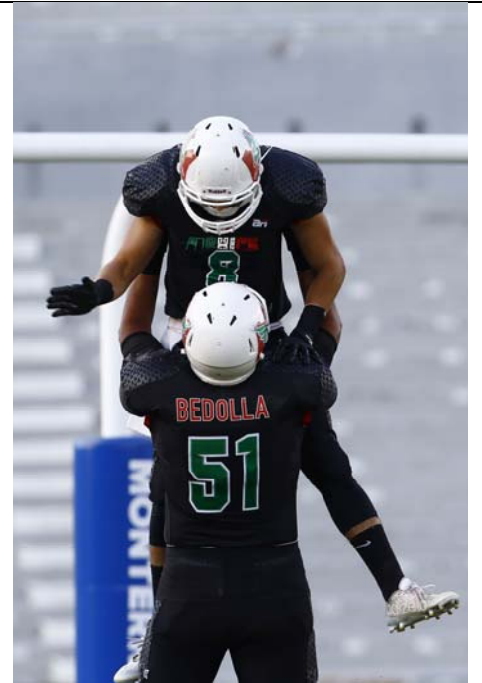

Team Mexico defeats Team Japan to get the third victory in a row

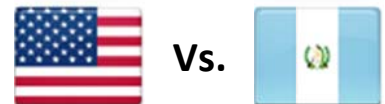


With a great performance on the offensive from RB Fernando Mejia, the Mexican national team beat Japan with a score of 36-6 in front of a crowd of about 8,500 fans who witnessed a big party at the World University Championship of American Football in the Monterrey Tech Stadium this Wednesday evening.

Mejia Chavez carried the ball twice and gained 75 yards to score in the first drive of the Mexican , Rodrigo Arias made the extra point to put the score 7-0, to the surprise of the Japanese.

Another run of 53 yards in the same first quarter by Fernando Mejia brought the second touchdown for Mexico and the extra was good to

make it 14-0.

Japan in the second quarter broke the zero with a field goal of 38 yards by Kenichi Otsuka to go to halftime with a score of 14-3.

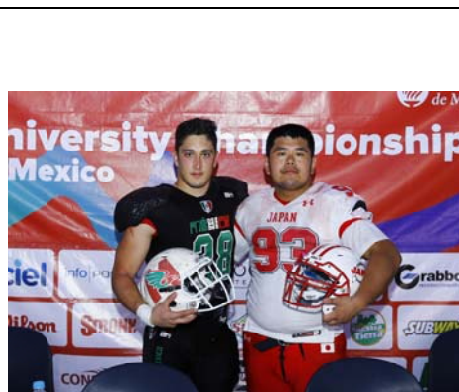
In the third period quarterback Francisco Mata made the perfect couple and Leonardo Magallanes, worked perfectly to complete a 68 yards pass for a touchdown that help Mexico to increase their advantage 21-3.

For the last quarter, Fernando Mejia appeared once again for a five yards run to get his 3rd touchdown of the evening and make the score 28-3.

Max Villarreal, who replaced Mata as a quarterback, ran 67 yards for the fifth touchdown of the game, Rodrigo Arias got a 2 point conversion for the final score of 36 points to 3.

The most valuable player was Fernando Mejia Mexico for his 223 rushing yards on 13 attempts, while Japan was Hiroaki Nakazato.

Mexico will have their last game against Team USA Saturday June 11 where it is expected a large turnout by football fans.
